As well as being unattractive and annoying, ticks can transmit diseases such as Lyme disease, anaplasmosis, babesiosis and Rocky-Mountain spotted fever.

HOW TO PREVENT BEING BITTEN:

Wear full-length, loose-fitting clothing which is light-coloured so it is easy to spot insects. Tuck pants into socks, inspect for ticks and shower after coming from the outdoors. Inspect pets for ticks when they return indoors.

USE INSECT REPELLENT:

Use insect repellent before going outdoors paying particular attention to the feet. Ask your pharmacist about a longer-lasting, non-oily version which is preferred for children 6 months to 12 years of age and won't dissolve plastics.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE BITTEN:

Remove tick by its mouthparts with tweezers instead of your hands to avoid squeezing potential bacteria into your blood. Wash area with soap and water or rubbing alcohol. Save the tick for identification.

A simple antibiotic will prevent Lyme disease if tick has been attached for longer than 36 hours. See your doctor if you develop a bull's eye rash within 30 days or if you develop a fever.
